Screening Resources for Breast & Cervical Cancer

Detecting cancer early means quicker treatment, more effective treatment, a better chance of recovering, and less risk to your health and life.

Who qualifies for assistance?

Uninsured, underinsured, medically underserved and minority women, and women who have never been screened for breast or cervical cancer who are:

- ▲ 50 years of age and older for mammography screenings.
- ▲ 40 years of age and older for cervical cancer screenings.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To qualify for MS-BCCP, a woman must meet all of the following guidelines:

- ▲ **Income:** Household income at or below 250% of Federal Poverty Level.
- ▲ **Insurance status:** Uninsured, underinsured, or without third-party payers such as Medicaid or Medicare Part B
- ▲ **Resident:** State of Mississippi for at least 12 consecutive months
- ▲ **Enrollment Age:** 21-64 years old, as follows:
 - ▲ **For cervical cancer screening:**
Age 21 to 64
 - ▲ **For breast cancer screening:**
Age 40 to 64
 - ▲ For women aged 40-49 years old, breast screening is offered. Providers must call BCCP for prior approval.
 - ▲ **For breast or cervical diagnostic services:**
Age 21 to 64
- ▲ **Enrolled by:** A contracted BCCP Provider

What services are available?

- ▲ Screening and/or diagnostic mammograms annually for women 40-64 years of age
- ▲ Women who are over the age of 64 without a social security number may qualify for screening and diagnostic services
- ▲ Women ages 21-39 may qualify for screening and diagnostic services
- ▲ Diagnostic mammogram, ultrasound, and breast biopsies, if indicated
- ▲ Cervical biopsies, if indicated

Breast Imaging Fund

Do you need breast imaging services but don't have health insurance or are under-insured? The Memorial Hospital Foundation's Breast Imaging Fund may be able to help!

What breast imaging services does the fund cover?

- ⌘ Digital screening mammography
 - ⌘ Digital diagnostic mammography
 - ⌘ Breast ultrasound
 - ⌘ Breast MRI
 - ⌘ Breast biopsy* (ultrasound, MRI or stereotactic)
- *Pathology fees may not be covered.

What are the fund guidelines?

- ⌘ Orders from your provider are required for a breast imaging procedure.
- ⌘ All breast cancer imaging procedures must be performed at Memorial Hospital or a Memorial Diagnostic Imaging Center.
- ⌘ Applications must be completed thoroughly with personal income information.

How do you access the fund?

You will need to indicate to a Memorial Patient Access Representative at pre-registration or registration that you are in financial need. Your Patient Access Representative will assist you with completing an application.
